

ANNUAL MEETING 2016 - Genova, June 15-17, 2016

CALL FOR PHD STUDENTS CONTRIBUTIONS

GTTI Annual Meeting will be held in Genoa, June 15th - 17th, 2016.

Within the scientific program of the Meeting, a session dedicated to present **contributions coming from PhD Students** and structured into the following Scientific Areas has been scheduled:

- **Communications**
- **Networking**
- **Remote Sensing**
- **Signal Processing**

Contributors are invited to submit a brief **document** for evaluation containing:

- Name and Surname, Phd cycle, and Scientific Area
- Description of the Research Activity (maximum 2 pages)
- Publications (Journals/magazines, books, book chapters, conferences)
- Followed Conferences and Workshops (both presenting and not presenting papers)
- Educational and Training Activity (Followed Courses, Seminars, and Schools)
- Experience developed outside the University where students are developing their PhD specifying: developed activity (very short), period of time, and hosting institution
- Awards and scientific recognitions

In Description of the Research Activity the following aspects must be stressed, since they will be used as evaluation parameters: Relevance to the Scientific Areas, Originality, Execution Modalities, Feasibility, Clarity of the presentation.

Selected contributors will be able to present their research in the form of posters and through a short 2/3 minute oral presentation for discussion with members of the national / international scientific community during the special session appearing in the Meeting program. Each poster must be printed as an A1 sheet or composed within the framework of an A1 sheet.

All selected candidates will attend the ANNUAL MEETING 2016, including the social dinner, without the payment of the registration fee.

Among the selected contributions, the Scientific Committee will indicate up to 3 contributions for thematic area, which will be evaluated during the poster presentation by a

Joint Committee CNIT-GTTI, so to assign up to 3 "**Best Junior Carassa Award 2016**" including a contribution of **700 € for each award**, offered by CNIT.
